The Dauphin Fire Department and its members have been serving the citizens for over a century.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- Must be at least 18 years of age.
- Must possess the mental and physical health to adequately perform the duties of a firefighter.
- ✓ Must have a valid Class 5F license.
- ✓ Must submit the following:
 - ✓ Criminal Record Check
 - ✓ Vulnerable Sector Inquiry
 - ✓ Manitoba Driver's License Abstract

DFD provides all training and equipment for new members.

PRACTICES, TRAINING AND WEEKEND STANDBY

It is expected that members will attend weekly Wednesday night practices. They will be compensated for their time.

Once members have completed the firefighting training, it is expected that required on-going education will continue. Examples of additional training include:

- First aid and CPR training,
- Traffic control management,
- Vehicle extrication training,
- Fire ground management,
- Hazardous materials response,
- Surface water rescue.

During the summer months, to ensure protection of our citizens, weekend standby is established. This schedule covers July and August in addition to long weekends. Weekend standby may also be assigned at other times of the year. Platoons are assigned on a rotation to cover weekend standby. Each firefighter on weekend standby is paid for each day covered.

As a member of the department, you will be provided training for the Class 3F with air endorsement driver's license. DFD will reimburse you the cost of your driver's license medical exam, one attempt at each of the written and road tests, written air brake test and practical air brake test.



PAY SCALE

- Firefighter Recruit \$15.50/hr.
 - New member.
- Probationary Firefighter \$18.50/hr.
 - Member has completed the Fire
 Fighting Level I (NFPA 1001) practical
 and written exams.
- Class III Firefighter \$20.00/hr.
 - Achieved after 1 continuous year as a Probationary Firefighter.
- Class II Firefighter \$21.50/hr.
 - Achieved after 3 continuous years of service from date of promotion to Class III firefighter status.
- Class I Firefighter \$23.00/hr.
 - Achieved after 3 continuous years of service from date of promotion to Class II firefighter status.
- Weekend Standby \$45.00/day.
